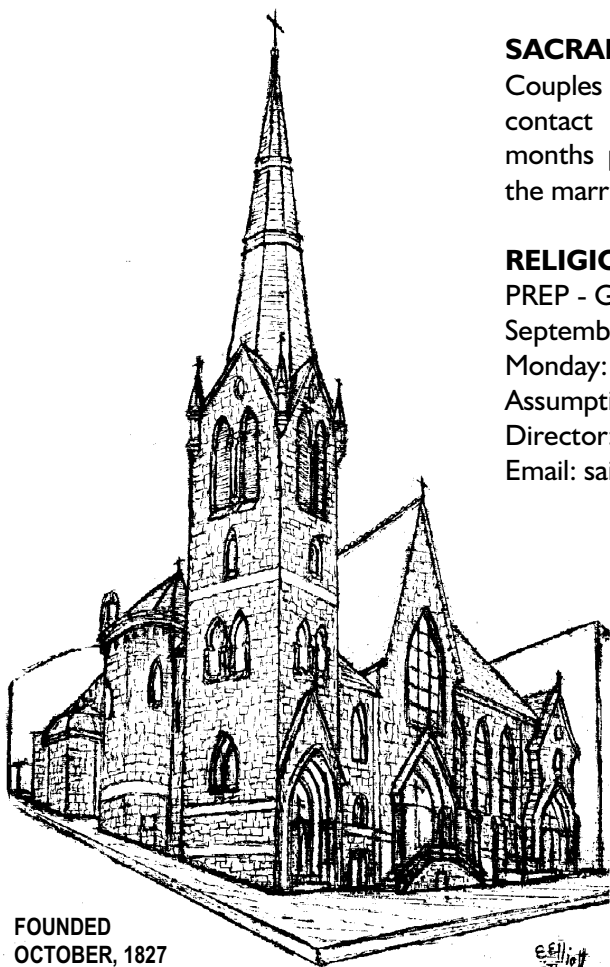

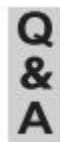

Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Blessed Trinity and has the same



majesty as the Father and the Son. At the Last Supper, Jesus told his disciples about the coming of the Holy Spirit, who would remind them of Christ’s teachings and continue to lead them “to all truth.” *“The Advocate, the holy spirit that the Father will send in my name—he will teach you everything and remind you of all that (I) told you”* (John 14:26). As Jesus promised, the Holy Spirit descended on the Church at Pentecost and has continued to guide the Church ever since.

“To be in touch with Christ, we must first have been touched by the Holy Spirit. He comes to meet us and kindles faith in us” (CCC #683). God sends the Spirit into our hearts and makes us his children (Galatians 4:6). We first receive the Holy Spirit at our Baptism, from whom we receive sanctifying grace. His presence in our souls is strengthened at Confirmation.

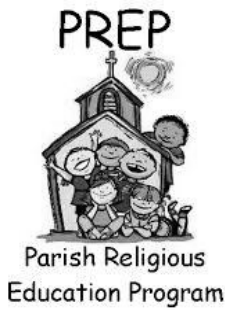


Not only can we support St. Patrick Parish now, but well



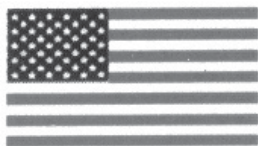
