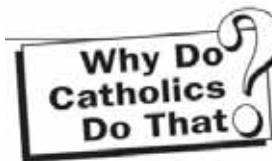

Why do Catholics use sacramentals?

Sacramentals are sacred signs that, through the intercession of the Church, dispose us to receive the effects of the Sacraments. They make holy various occasions in human life (*Constitution on Sacred Liturgy*). For example, liturgical prayers and actions in which we participate can be considered sacramentals. Holy water, ashes, candles, and objects used in liturgical celebrations can be sacramentals. Unlike Sacraments, sacramentals weren’t originated by Christ, but they remind us to live holy lives and dedicate ourselves to God’s glory.

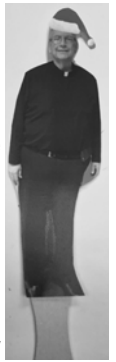
